

ATTORNEY REFERRAL PROGRAM INSTRUCTIONS

United Faculty of Florida members have access to two different referral programs for legal assistance for **non-employment related matters**: the [NEA Attorney Referral Program](#), and the [AFL-CIO's Union Plus Legal Program](#). Both programs screen and pre-select attorneys throughout the state to consult and/or provide select services to UFF members at a substantial discount. attorney referral lists are both accessible online and will require the member to create an online account (no charge) in order to access the lists. The attorneys are listed by location with their area of specialty on both programs.

The NEA Attorney Referral Program provides NEA members the benefit of discounted legal advice. During each NEA membership year each member has:

- Discounted rates below usual fees of participating attorneys.
- Access to certain legal assistance at rates below participating attorneys' usual fees
- Five core areas for discounted legal services.
 - Wills and Estates
 - Real Estate
 - Consumer Protection
 - Domestic Relations
 - Traffic Violations

Legal services in other areas or by attorneys not participating in NEA's Attorney Referral Program are not provided at NEA discounted rates.

Free Lawyer Consultation and Review

No enrollment forms or fees are required. Union members are automatically enrolled and are entitled to the following benefits for each separate legal matter:

- *A free initial consultation with a lawyer of up to 30 minutes (in person or over the phone),*
- *A free simple document review and explanation*
- *A free follow-up letter or phone call, if likely to resolve a legal matter.*
- *Most additional services are discounted by 30% (including attorney's hourly rates and flat fees for most common legal cases.)*
