UFF and FEA to Host 'Public Education Day of Action,' Press Conference on March 7

The United Faculty of Florida (UFF) and the Florida Education Association (FEA) will hold a coordinated day of action on Tuesday, March 7, focused on protecting and preserving Florida's public education system, PreK through graduate school. **Events on Tuesday will include**:
